Eligibility:

TEFAP Program: Applicant must verbally confirm they are a Connecticut resident and qualify, according to the income guidelines as set by The Emergency Food Assistance Program, (TEFAP). Income guidelines can be found at our website, <https://plymouthfoodpantry.org/tefap/> or by calling our office, (860)584-1750.

Plymouth Program: Applicant must be a Plymouth resident and will be asked to show identification for each member of the household and proof of address for each member of the household 18 or older.

Households may shop or order online. All shopping or pick up is by appointment. Call **860-584-1750** and leave a clear message, stating your name and phone number (please leave one message only). We will return your call by the next shopping day.

Home delivery is available for homebound customers. Homebound is defined according to the criteria as set by Medicare. Prior to being placed on a delivery schedule, the customer must demonstrate that they qualify.
