

### **Public Service Announcement regarding Wetland Permit Application**

**If you live near or have wetlands on your property you may need to get a permit to do any work in that area. If you live in a lake community, you still need to get a permit from the Inland-Wetlands Commission. If you are not sure if you are in need of a permit, feel free to come to an Inland-Wetlands Commission meeting. We would be happy to answer any questions you may have. Inland-Wetlands Commission meetings are conducted on the first and third Wednesday of each month, with no meetings being held in the month of August.**
